



Ezra Pecha

April 3, 1957 - December 18, 2023

Ezra Pecha was born April 3, 1957 in Petach Tikvah, Israel. He is survived by his wife Ruth (Sudilovksy) Pecha and children Eden and Nadav. He passed away on Monday, December 18th surrounded by his family after a long battle with pancreatic cancer. He was the son of Juliet Levy and Yitzhak Pecha, step-son of Shlomo Levy, grandson of Saalem and Tufacha, and the great-grandson of Simcha.). He is survived by his sisters and many nieces and nephews. Ezra was always proud of his Iraqi-Israeli Jewish heritage.

Ezra's early years were spent in the Beit Yisrael neighborhood in Jerusalem. These years provided a formative experience that never really left him. He spent the later part of his youth moving around Israel. After the death of his step-father (before his bar mitzvah), he moved between England and Israel. At the age of 17, he left Israel for the England - before eventually making his way to the US. Nonetheless, his heart remained in Israel for rest of his life. He returned to Israel as a young adult. It was in Israel where he met his wife Ruth. Israel was also where his children were born.

Ezra spent his career in sales - carpets, cars, and appliances. He was recognized for his his honesty and integrity and made life-long friends with co-workers and customers alike. Ezra treasured human relationships above all else. He was beloved by many. He reached out and made sure that others felt loved as well. His open heartedness and kindness made him friends wherever

he went.

The funeral will be held at Cleveland Jewish Funerals (26801 Miles Road) at 1pm on Tuesday December 19th. Burial will be held at Mount Olive Cemetery (27855 Aurora Rd, Solon, OH 44139) immediately after.
