



Larisa Bogolubov

October 3, 1941 - February 21, 2026

Larisa Bogolubov passed away on February 23, 2026. She was 84 years old. Her parents Solomon and Luba (Dvorkin) Bogolubov had two children, Boris (deceased) and Larisa. While the family had its origins in Ukraine, like millions of Soviet citizens, they fled eastward during the Great War. Larisa was born in the Chuvash Republic on October 3, 1941 where she lived for the duration of the fighting. After the war, the family returned to Ukraine.

Larisa was an educated woman who trained as a chemist and worked in this field for many years. She enjoyed cooking, knitting, reading, and crossword puzzles. She is survived by a daughter Alla (Alec) Vinokur of Solon and two granddaughters Sabrina and Ava. In 1995, Alla moved to Israel and Larisa joined her in 1997. Later, Alla moved to Cleveland in 2001 and Larisa followed her in 2016.

Her funeral will be held at Noon on Wednesday, February 25, 2026 at Cleveland Jewish Funerals (26801 Miles Road, Cleveland, OH 44128) followed by burial at Zion Memorial Park (5461 Northfield Road, Bedford Heights, OH 44146) immediately after the memorial service. Rabbi Zushe Greenberg will officiate.
