Mr. Sam Friedland passed away on April 24, 2023. Sam was born in pre-war Poland to Yitzchak and Chana Friedland. His two sisters, Sonya (Shaindel) and Fannie (Fanya) pre-deceased him. Mr. Friedland was a Holocaust survivor who moved to the United States in 1952. He spent his career working for Ford Motor Company, where he retired in 1992. Mr. Friedland married his wife Jane in 1959. They remained married until her passing in 2014.
