



## Susan Fierman

September 6, 1940 - July 27, 2025

Susan Fierman passed away on July 27, 2025. She was 84 years old. Susan was born on September 6, 1940 in Youngstown, OH to Herman and Lillian (Rosenbaum) Horowitz - although the family later changed the name to Horn due to antisemitism. The family had three daughters, including an older sister Barbara (deceased) of Chicago, IL and Alice (Allie) Gorajczyk of Scottsdale, AZ.

The young family spent some early years in Daytona Beach, FL but later returned to Youngstown to help care for Susan's recently widowed (maternal) grandfather. Susan early on displayed kindness and dedication to her family. She demonstrated this by helping care for her ailing grandfather and mothering her baby sister Allie.

As a young woman, Susan was active in Temple Rodef Sholom of Youngstown. She later graduated from Rayen High School. She was popular and well liked, earning the nickname "Sweet Sue."

After graduation, she attended Ohio State University, but returned to Youngstown to take a job at St. Elizabeth Hospital as an X-Ray stenographer. In 1962, she moved to Cleveland where she continued her career in this field at a number of health care institutions.

While in Cleveland, Susan met her husband Ronald. The young couple were married in 1967 and remained together for 50 years until his death. While they were unable to have a child of their own, they traveled to Turkey in 1974 in order to adopt their beloved son Joel.

Susan enjoyed sports and was a committed fan of many Ohio based teams. She was a big fan of the Cleveland Indians throughout her life. Susan was a caring wife, mother, and sister and enjoyed cooking and baking - particularly with her son Joel. She provided comfort and assistance to many sick members of her extended family. She was also beloved by her many nieces and nephews who lovingly referred to her as Aunt Susie. She was universally known as a selfless woman with a caring disposition and big heart.
