



Yuriy Yurkovskiy

September 2, 1936 - October 19, 2025

Yuriy Yurkovskiy, aged 89, passed away on October 19, 2025. He was born on September 2, 1936, in the central Asian city of Tashkent, then in the USSR. He is predeceased by his parents, David and Maria (Dvoskina) Yurkovskiy and survived by his sister Mira Yurkovskaya.

He was born during a difficult time in history. While the family had origins in the territory of today's Belorussia, like millions of Soviet citizens they fled to the vast interior of the country in anticipation of -or in reaction to- the Nazi invasion.

Yuriy became an electrical engineer with a specialization in radio technology. He loved playing chess, solving puzzles, reading, and swimming. He held a particular love of photography which was a longtime hobby of his.

He is survived by his beloved wife Yuliya (Dvoskina) Yurkovskaya and two daughters, Olga Yurkovskaya (Roman Belkin) and Maria Yurkovskaya (Zelig Avrasin). He was a loving uncle to Arthur Yurkovskiy and Ella (Yurkovskaya) Farber as well as a proud grandfather to eight beautiful grandchildren and one great grandchild.

A graveside funeral will be held on Tuesday, October 21, 2025, at Mount Olive Cemetery at 1:00 PM. Cantor Misha Pisman will be officiating.
